

At Castle School we celebrate and promote good attendance in the following ways:



- Report our attendance procedures clearly (see attached leaflet on this webpage)
- Update you with useful tips on how you can help your child with their attendance (via the School Newsletter/email and School App)
- Update the Attendance tab (website Homepage) with year group attendance figures and whole school attendance. We also have an Attendance board outside by the main Reception entrance
- The School Gateway App updates daily with details about your child's attendance which you can track from home – Personalised termly email with your child's attendance figures
- Update you with your child's individual attendance at Parents Meetings/Evenings and reports
- A child who is finding it difficult to be at school for whatever reason after discussion with the parent may be rewarded with Head Teacher stickers, after a select period of time to encourage and promote a feeling of pride
- Certificate of Achievement – for pupils to promote a sense of pride and wellbeing for their work, behaviour and attendance
- Teachers are provided with a weekly attendance sheet so they can discuss and celebrate with their classes – best class attendance for that week receives a certificate to display
- Pupils that have made good progress will be rewarded by a message/certificate home to parents celebrating their achievement
- Celebrate children with 100% attendance at the end of each term (certificate in assembly)
- Any child with 100% at the end of the academic year will receive a special reward (to be determined by the Head)
- Termly assembly promoting and discussing the benefits of good attendance
