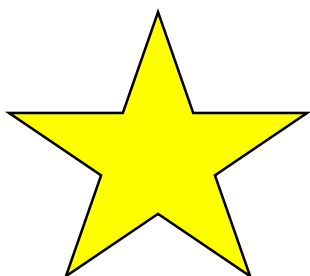
Dear Parent/Carer

Our annual sports day is due to take place next week, Monday 19th June. Looking back at the successful sports days we have had in the past years, we are aiming to run the day in a similar way. This means that the KS2 sports day will be in the morning, starting at 9.30am and running to approximately 12.00pm and the KS1 sports day will be in the afternoon, starting at 1.15pm and running to approximately 3.00pm. Each Key Stage will follow the same programme, a carousel of activities where each child will compete in their class or house group, followed by the year group races.

As per the norm, all parents, friends and family are invited in to the school to support the children as they participate. Spectators will be allowed onto the school grounds 5 minutes before the start time.

Although some of the events may not be in fitting with a traditional sports day, there are some things we can't change which is why would we like the parents to get involved in the battle of the brave for the infamous 'Parent Race' at the end of each KS's event.

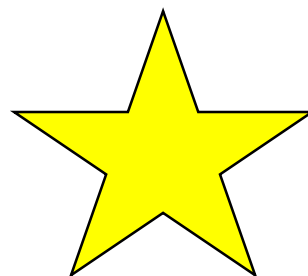


Drogo – Red
